Eligibility Guidelines

- Participants must be in grades K-12.
- Participants must reside, attend school, or participate through an organization within a Cal Water service area.

Artwork Guidelines

- Artwork must be the student's original work.
- Artwork must focus on caring for water (conservation, water cycle, watershed).
- The artwork should address a local California water concern.
- Artwork must be fine art: painting, sketching, inks, coloring, etc.
- Submitted artwork must be no larger than 24" x 36" x 1 1/2".
- Artwork may not be 3-dimensional in nature.
- Artwork may not be photographic, cinematic, or animated.

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Statement Guidelines

- Submissions must include an artist's statement.
- Statements must be at least a paragraph long.
- 3. Statement can be no more than 500 words.
- Statements should explain the medium of the submitted artwork and how it was created.
- Statements should further include the message of the submitted artwork, and how it reflects the theme of caring for water.
- Statements may include additional information if desired.
